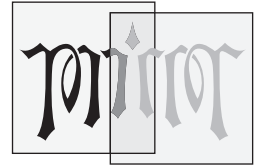


# Ambigrams

Each design below is actually half of a word. To make the whole words, take two copies of this page and slide one on top of the other until the two copies of a particular design make a whole word. Hold the pages up to the light to see through the paper. You may have to turn or flip the page. No folding allowed.

For instance, the first design makes the word "Mirror" if you flip the paper to look through the back. Can you figure out what the other words say?
