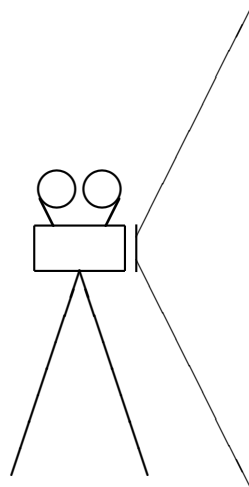


Hardy:
